- II. The real Biblical call of Christ is found in Matthew 4:17-22; 9:9; 1Kings 18:21
- III. In following Jesus, we become His disciples
 - 1. The term Disciple comes from 2 Greek words

Man-than-o = to follow

Math-ey-tes = to be a learner

- 2. God's desire for us in following Jesus is that we become like Christ Matthew 10:24-25, Romans 8:28-29, Galatians 1:15-16; 4:19-20
- 3. This call of Christ, demands a decision on our part, no such thing as neutrality, you must decide. 1Kings 18:21
- IV. The DEMANDS of following Jesus
 - 1. Like the disciples of Jesus' day, you all have your own ideas of what following Jesus means. And like the disciples of Jesus' day, your wrong.
 - 2. You need the correct, Biblical understanding of what it is to follow Jesus.
 - 3. First demand is REPENT Matthew 4:17, 3 parts to Biblical Repentance

1st Amos 3:3 Change of mind

2nd 2Corinthians 7:8-10 Change of heart

3rd John 8:1-11 Change of direction

- 4. Second demand is Die to self Luke 9:23; Luke 14:27
- 5. Third demand is Love God Supremely Luke 14:26, Matthew 22:36-37

- 6. Fourth demand is Forsake all that you have Luke 14:33
- V. How these demands were met by various people
 - 1. Luke 9:57-62
 - 2. 1Kings 18:21
 - 3. John 6:60-66
 - 4. Luke 12:13-15
 - 5. Matthew 16:21-26; Matthew 26:30-35
- VI. Following Christ in a Biblical way will cost you everything, not following Him will cost you more. You must count the cost. Luke 14:28-32
 - 1. Will you deny yourself and take up the cross daily and follow Jesus?
