Class Description

This class is the best of Pastor Kevin's teachings. The students will study the calling and character of several people in the Bible. How did God call them? How did He prepare them? How did He break them and make them usable for His kingdom? These are some of the questions that will be studied in the class.

Objectives

- 1. That each student would gain an understanding of how God shapes and molds His servants.
- 2. To be encouraged by God's faithfulness and love.
- 3. That each student would be encouraged in their personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

Class Requirements

- 1. Attendance Each student needs to watch all video classes and participate in all video meetings.
- 2. Daily Homework Each student needs to complete the daily homework assigned.
- 3. Final Project A 3-5 page paper as explained below.
- 4. Read: "THE MAN GOD USES" by Chuck Smith and keep a journal with at least 1 written page for each chapter

Day	Homework
Day #1	Read Exodus Chapter 3. Begin to work on final essay. Begin to read and journal through "The Man God Uses"
Day #2	Read Exodus 32 & 33. Read John 13-17. Read verses on faithfulness (1 Corinthians 4:2, 1 Corinthians 15:58, 2 Chronicles 16:9, Hebrews 3:2, and Matthew 25:21)
Day #3	Read Exodus 34. Read John 15:1-8.
Day #4	Read Exodus 34. Continue to work on final paper. Continue to read and journal through book.
Day #5	Read Jonah 1-4
Day #6	Reread Jonah 1-4. Read Jeremiah 1
Day #7	Read 1 Samuel 16 & 17
Day #8	Read 2 Samuel 11 & 12
Day #9	Finalizar el trabajo final y el libro con el diario.
Final Project	3-5 page paper (4-6 if hand written) Pick a king of Judah who is not Solomon or David. Write an essay including the following aspects: Find the time of history for the king. What was Judah's condition (sin?) What was happening with other nations? What was happening politically and religiously? How did the king fail? How did he succeed? What can you learn from this? Imagine being in his shoes. This is due at the end of the course.
