Class Description

This class is an overview of Ephesians designed to help students understand the salvation God has provided and how to live it out. Pastor Bill breaks down the book into clear divisions that allow God's message understood and applied.

Objectives

- 1. Gain a clear understanding of the book of Ephesians.
- 2. To be encouraged to pray the Bible and experience God's promises.
- 3. To understand how to rightly divide the Word of God.

Class Requirements

- 1. Attendance Each student needs to watch all video classes and participate in all video meetings.
- 2. Daily Homework Each student needs to complete the daily homework assigned in the course outline.
- 3. Final Project A 3-5 page paper as explained below.
- **4.** Read: "Encounter Ephesians" by Bill Holdridge. Students will only be required to answer the questions in the outline.

Day	Homework
Day #1	Read the entire book of Ephesians in the Bible. Reach the introduction and week 1 of "Encounter Ephesians" Answer questions pertaining to Class #1 from outline.
Day #2	Read chapter 1-3 of the book of Ephesians. Read weeks 2 and 3 of "Encounter Ephesians" Answer questions pertaining to Class #2 from outline.
Day #3	Read the entire book of Ephesians in the Bible for the 2nd time. Read week 4 of "Encounter Ephesians" Answer questions pertaining to Class #3 from outline.
Day #4	Read chapters 4-5 of the book of Ephesians. Read week 5 of "Encounter Ephesians" Answer questions pertaining to Class #4 from outline.
Day #5	Read entire book of Ephesians from the Bible for the 3rd time. Complete the book "Encounter Ephesians" Answer questions pertaining to Class #5 from outline.
Final Project	3-5 page paper (4-6 if hand written) What is the Spiritual Battle? What are the schemes of the devil? What is the armor of God? How do we have victory? (Please use biblical references)
